Notes : HSV infection occurs world wide. The incubation period following exposure is about one week (range 2 to 26 days). HSV 1 & 2 viruses serotypes a fir degree of cross - reactivity. Infection with one virus may also result in a high antibody titre against the heterologous serotype. Presence of IgG does not indicate reinfection, recurrent infection or immunity. Serological assay alone should not be used as the sole basis for diagnosis of a recurrent or current infection. All other appropriate clinical findings and laboratory data must be considered.
