Comments : Rhelax CRP slide test for detection of CRP is based on the principle of agglutination. The test specimen (serum) is mixed with Rhelax CRP latex reagent and allowed to react. If CRP concentration is greater than 0.6 mg/dl a visible agglutination is observed. If CRP concentration is less than 0.6 mg / dl, then no agglutination is observed. Agglutination is a positive test result and indicates the presence of CRP in the test specimen. No agglutination is a negative test result and indicates the absence of CRP in the test specimen.
